This event is for students in the humanities and social sciences who are starting to write research proposals – often 2nd and 3rd year students, but any student who is beginning to develop a project may apply. The workshop is a way to get started on a proposal and to learn more about how to fund that particular research. Students who apply must submit a two-page draft proposal with their application, and can develop these initial drafts into full proposals to submit for the spring Intensive Grant Writing Workshop.

Your **draft proposal** should be 2 pages long—double-spaced, 12 point font, 1 inch margins. It should describe your proposed project and should...

- explain the project's goals and significance;
- clearly state when and where the research will be situated, and explain why the time and location are appropriate;
- describe the kinds of evidence and methodology the research will use;
- describe your qualifications and preparations for carrying out the research.

The application is due by Friday, October 17. Notice of acceptance will be sent by Friday, October 24.
