The Proposal Writing Institute is designed for students in the humanities and social sciences who are in the process of revising well developed draft proposals for specific funding agencies – whether for research, write-up, or post-doctoral projects. Participants submit a proposal completed in accordance with the requirements of an actual funding agency. The Institute provides extensive feedback from an interdisciplinary group of faculty who will review proposals and interview applicants using the same standards and criteria as external funding committees. It also provides opportunities to discuss aspects of the proposals in individual sessions with faculty.

The Institute is an ideal next step for students who attended the Intensive Grant Writing Workshop.

Students can be admitted to the Institute either by having attended the Intensive Grant Writing Workshop or by asking their programs to nominate them. Potential participants must submit a completed funding proposal.

Application information will be sent in March to recent participants in the Intensive Grant Writing Workshop and to Directors of Graduate Studies in all humanities and social science programs. **Applications and nominations will be due on Friday, April 3.**
